The Church's Jubilee Year 2025 begins in four and a half weeks time with the opening of the Holy Door in St Peter's Basilica in Rome by Pope Francis at the Christmas Eve Mass. The Jubilee Year, occurring every 25 years will continue until the celebration of the Epiphany of Our Lord, 6th January 2026. The theme, chosen by Pope Francis is 'Pilgrims of Hope.
